Highlighted Subpopulations:

Currently we are seeing increases in headcount across all races/ethnicities. Compared to Fall 24 (+10.0%)

-44 (+11.6%), 4554 (+8.0%), 55-
64 (+0.9%), and 65+ (+4.1%). Enrollment among non-traditional students (adults aged 25
and over) has increased by 9.8% from the same time last year, now accounting for 29.8% of
the total enrollment.

When evaluating enrollment headcount by academic load, we see that both full-time and
part-time students are up compared to the prior year. Full-time enrollment (students taking
12 hours or more) is up 7.2% across the system and part-time enrollment (students taking less
